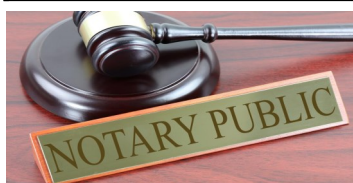

Is your account Dormant?
Has your account been Escheated?
What you need to know

Washington State law defines a dormant account as any account that has not had activity for a period of one year. Dormant Accounts are subject to a special handling fee of \$5.00 per month.

After a period of three years these Dormant Accounts become "Unclaimed Property". The Credit Union is required by Washington State law to turn all "Unclaimed Property" over to the Department of Revenue. These accounts then become "Escheated". After an account has been "escheated", you must contact the State of Washington to claim your money.

Letters will be sent out to all Dormant Account holders in July, and final notices are mailed in September. On October 31st, all "Unclaimed Property", will be sent to the State of Washington.

While the Supervisory Committee and staff make every effort to contact you before this happens, it is important that you review all your statements. Every financial institution in the State of Washington is required to comply with these same regulations.

How can you activate your account? Come by or call the Credit Union! Making a small deposit or withdrawal is all it takes. If it is an account you are no longer using, perhaps it can be consolidated with another account. That counts too!!
